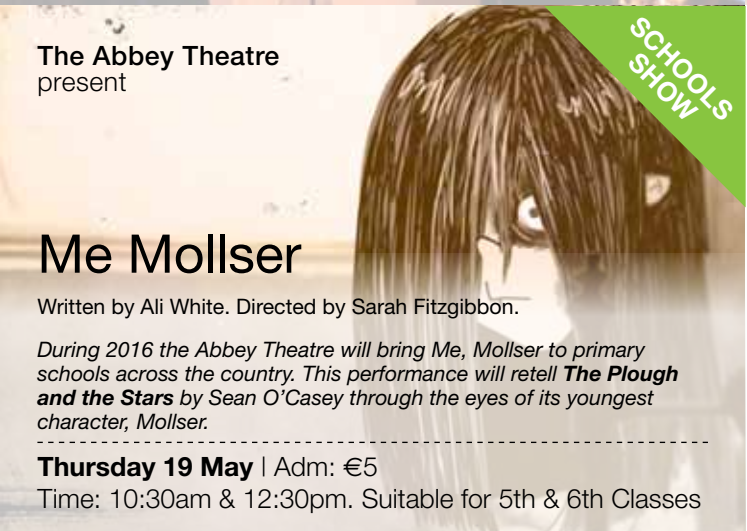


The Golden Age of Big Band Vegas

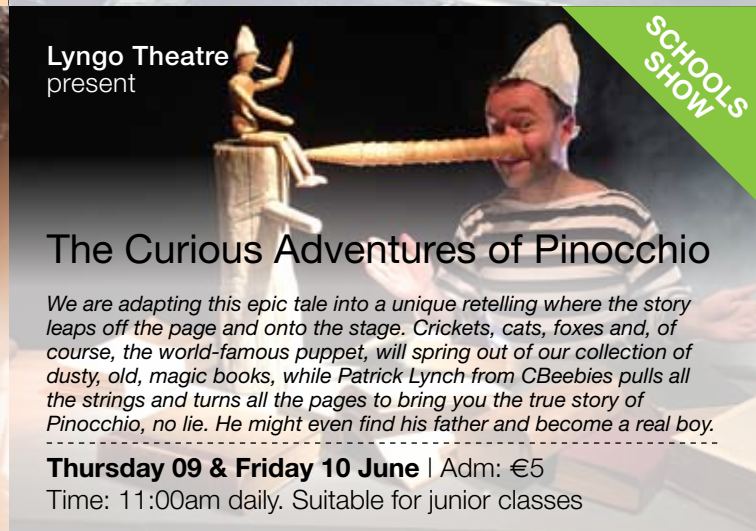

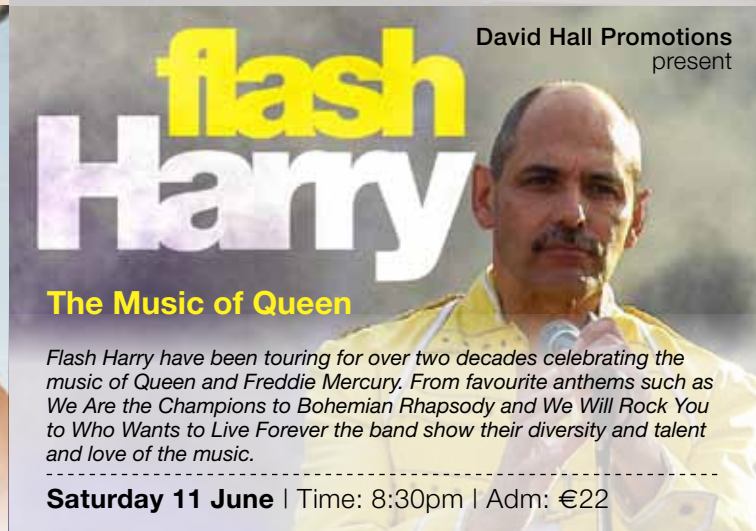
